
CLEMSON CENTRAL COLLARBONE, LAWRENCE, ROCKY, ISSAQUEENA, & DAM RD TRAILS in Clemson Forest



DESCRIPTION: This local favorite skirts the east side of beautiful Issaqueena Lake in Clemson Experimental Forest. Starting from the main parking area on Old Six Mile Rd, head south beyond the kiosk on a path paralleling Dam Road. Just ahead is a controversial Clemson architectural project...a large tangle of white painted steel. There we join Collarbone Trail and follow it northwest for about a half mile to a multi trail junction. Take Lawrence to the left, and wind down across a small creek, then up to another junction. Jog left then right onto Rocky Extension. A second hairpin connects to Issaqueena Lake(side) Trail. Scenic marsh and lake views, over a mile of easy going, brings us to Issaqueena Dam...our usual lunch spot. We return via Dam Road (easiest) or the Dam Rd Trail (more scenic). Choose right turns at unmarked trail junctions! The total hike is just under 7 miles with only a few hundred feet of elevation gain.

DIRECTIONS: (GPS: 34.738367, -82.840931) Gather, pool, and depart from either KKEPA at 9A OR at 845 from Walhalla OR go direct to trailhead parking. From KKEPA go 2.2mi S on SC130, 1.6 E on SC183, 4 SE on Jones Mill, 2 S on SC133, 1 W (at Maws) on Old Six Mile. From Walhalla, take SC183 E 12mi to SC130, then 0.2 N to KKEPA. There are no potties and no fees. Expect to return by 2PM.
