

MEDLIN MOUNTAIN to or from BURRELL'S FORD



DESCRIPTION: Medlin Mountain is a section of the FT (A10-A11) from Hatchery Rd to Burrells Ford. The mostly moderate trail is 4 miles each way with a net 900ft gradual descent from the Hatchery to the Chattooga. It includes some nice north and south winter views from the ridges plus a section of the Chattooga where we lunch. Spoonauger Fall, upstream on the Chattooga is a short add-on option. Reversing the starting point completes the climb outbound, making for an easier return, but a less scenic lunch spot.

DIRECTIONS (GPS: 34.977203, -83.0736 for Hatchery OR 34.971314, -83.114447 for Burrell's Ford)
Meet, pool, and depart as usual: 830AM from KKEPA and/or 900A from Walhalla. From there it's 8 miles NW on SC28, 12mi N on SC107, and 2 W on Hatchery Rd to the parking land trailhead on the left. (Same parking as for the hike to Sloan Bridge.) There are no fees. There are facilities at both the Fish Hatchery and Burrell's Ford.
Expect to return around 230PM.
