

TWIN FALLS TWIN (or REEDY) FALLS from TWO TRAIL HEADS

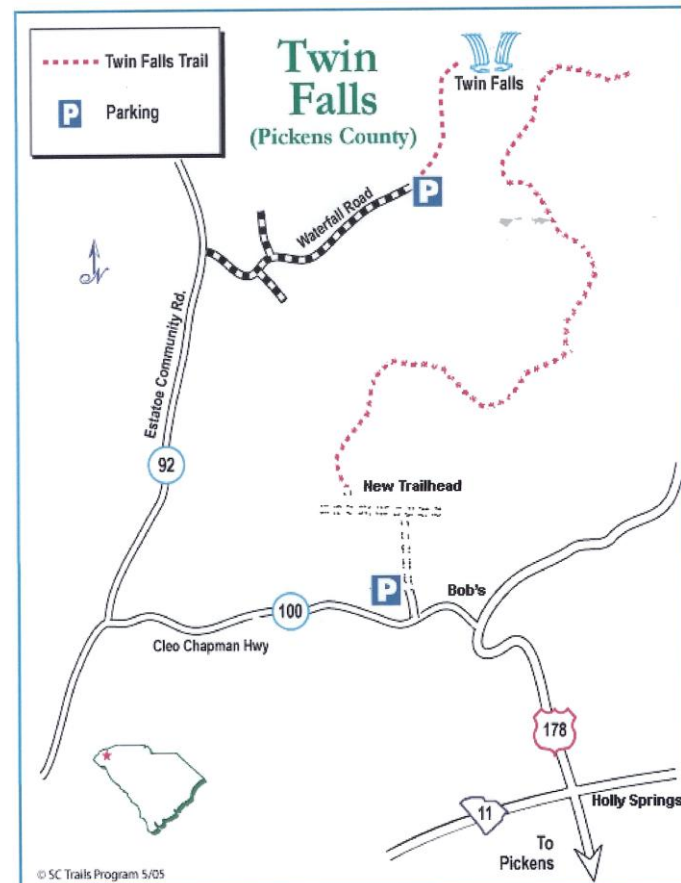
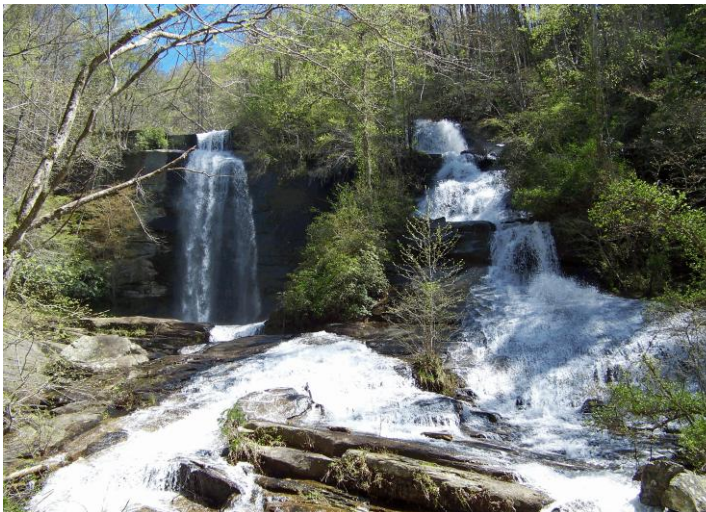
DESCRIPTION: Twin Falls doubles the pleasure with two ways in and multiple views of the amazing white water twins, their pristine source and outflow, plus remnants of an old logging railroad. The first route takes us to the top of the falls and its headwaters via 1.5 miles of easy to moderate trail with only a few hundred feet of climb each way. We then drive to the traditional access for an almost flat, half mile stroll way to the dazzling base of the falls. View from the covered pavilion and/or by clambering down to, and over, the rock base of the falls. Lunch streamside half way back. The total is thus only a bit over four miles.

DIRECTIONS (GPS: 35.003808, -82.806789)

Meet at HOLLY SPRINGS (SC11/US178) in time for a 930A departure from there. This requires leaving KKEPA by 9A. From Holly, go 3 NW on 178 then 0.5mi W on Cleo Chapman... a left behind Bob's Place. Park just off the road on the right for the first trailhead. There's only space for four or five cars. Ample parking for the second trailhead is at the end of Waterfall Rd, E off Eastatoe Community Rd (County 92) which is about a mile N of where Cleo Chapman tees with 92. .

No fees & no potties after Holly.

Expect to return by 2PM.
